Supporting the participation of migrant families in Flipped Learning

# **OBJECTIVE:**

The FLIPPMI project aims to stregthen the participation of migrant families in Flipped Learning through Family Learning methods by equipping Intrecultural Mediators with the necessary skills and resources to support the process.

## **PARTNERS:**

A multi-sectoral partnership of eight organizations experts in Family Learning and Flipped Learning, intercultural mediation, developing ICT-based tools, and supporting migrant families, working together to analyse the main needs that migrant parents and pupils are facing in school contexts.



# PROJECT RESULTS:

- A Matrix of Competencies.
- An Online Campus to train future Intercultural Mediators in school contexts.
